I. Read Luke 10:21-24

- A. What did Jesus mean when He said, "All things have been handed over to me by My Father" (see 1 Peter 1:2-4)?
- B. In verse 22, Jesus said "no one knows who the Son is except the Father, and who the Father is except the Son, and anyone to whom the Son wills to reveal Him." What does this mean?
- C. Read Matthew 16:15-19 and discuss in the context of Luke 10:22.
- D. In verses 23-24, Jesus speaks of the greater blessing the seventy had received. What did He mean?

II. Read Luke 10:25-37

- A. In verse 25, we are told of an incident in which an expert in the law questions Jesus about salvation. Do you think this was an honest inquiry or did the lawyer have other motives in questioning Jesus?
- B. Read Jeremiah 17:9 and discuss its relevance to the lawyer's inquiry.
- C. Why is the truth expressed in Jeremiah 17:9 important to remember in dealing with others?

- D. How does Jesus' question in verse 26 demonstrate His desire to develop rapport with the lawyer?
- E. The lawyer's answer parallels Jesus' own answer to a similar question that is described in a later incident recorded in Matthew 22:37-40. What does the lawyer's answer indicate?
- F. How does the lawyer's answer summarize the Ten Commandments?
- G. When Jesus responded in verse 28, "You have answered correctly, do this, and you will live," what was He really saying?
